A NOTE FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

This season at Intercultural Journeys has been an exploration of the wounds and markings of time — Scars and Emblems. When CLOSE UPS curator Ursula Rucker asked the series artists which kind of etching best described the heart of their artistic work, they all chose scars. They spoke of finding expression in their writing and performing for the broken pieces of themselves. Deep artistic exploration is possibly one of the most powerful means we have for making sense of the hurts of being human.

But upcoming February CLOSE UPS artist Sham-e-Ali Nayeem also mentions in her conversation with Rucker that for her, part of the power of the scar is that it is a symbol of healing. It is the broken flesh made whole again, in a new shape.

LOOKING FOR LIGHT is IJ's offering of a balm in this time of so many and varied wounds. In this unique concert gathered from previous online performances with Intercultural Journeys, these incredible artists — Falsa, Keisha Hutchins Hirlinger, Susan Hoffman Watts, Solomon Temple, Monnette Sudler, and Yosef Goldman — share songs of restoration, reflection and renewal.
